Traffic Notes

Temporary Road Closure – A portion of Lantzville Road (north of Ware Road to Huddlestone Road) will be closed from 9:45 am to 11:00 am Saturday, September 8, 2018 for the Minetown Day parade. Expect traffic delays, obey all directions given by traffic control, and please use caution with the increased pedestrian traffic.

Under Construction – A full road closure will occur on a portion of *Peterson Road* during the period of (*Aug.27-Oct.11, 2018*) when crews will be replacing the watermain on *Peterson Road running from Lynn Drive to Lantzville Road*. Single alternating traffic will occur, when required. Detour will be on Harby and Leland Road to access Lantzville Road.

Single alternating traffic will occur on *Metro & Mart Road* as required during the period of (*Sept. 17-Nov. 16, 2018*) when crews will be replacing the watermain. Have you paid your Property Taxes and Claimed your Home Owner Grant? – Property Taxes were due July 3, 2018. A 5% penalty on outstanding balances has been applied and a further 5% penalty will be applied at the end of October 1, 2018.

Tax Sale on September 24, 2018 – Property tax accounts with three years of unpaid taxes as of the last Monday in September must be sold at tax sale which, if required, will take place in the Council Chambers, Municipal Hall, 2nd Floor, 7192 Lantzville Road, Lantzville, BC on Monday, September 24th at 10:00 am. Properties in a tax sale are advertised in the newspaper.


