2019 Grants in Aid Applications

Early in 2019, Council of the District of Lantzville will consider applications for discretionary Grants in Aid for the 2019 calendar year. Funds available for grants are limited and subject to budgetary constraints. The primary purpose is to provide financial assistance to an organization for a specific project or event that benefits the residents of the District of Lantzville. The organization should be registered as a Society (or belong to a parent Society) under the laws of BC and/or Canada. Preference will be given to locally-based organizations whose efforts are community-based in nature. Council will not grant monies to a 'for profit' organization. Applications must be completed and submitted to the Municipal Hall, no later than *Friday, February 1, 2019*. Obtain an application form, including policy with guidelines, from Municipal Hall or www.lantzville.ca.

Food Waste, Garbage & Recycling Schedule

After New Year's Day, curbside collection resumes on Monday, January 7, 2019 with garbage and food waste pickup, and continues on Mondays through January and *up to and including Monday, February 11, 2019* even though the curbside collection schedule erroneously shows Family Day on Monday, February 11 instead of February 18, 2019. Please follow the Regional District of Nanaimo's schedule by placing your curbside collection at the curb on Monday, February 11, 2019. Collection moves to Tuesdays on February 19, 2019 following the February 18th statutory holiday. Please place your container at the curb by 8:00 am.

If adverse weather disrupts collection service...

the Regional District of Nanaimo (RDN) reports that the following procedure will apply:

- Take your material in for the night, this will help to deter pests.
- Have your material back at the curb by 8:00 am. Collection staff will attempt to pick up the missed material in the two days following the missed collection.
- If road conditions continue to prevent collection on the subsequent two (2) days, including weekends, the missed material will be collected on the next corresponding collection day. I.e., if your garbage was missed, you will be permitted twice the material on the *next garbage collection day*. Standard weight and size limits apply. - appointed Councillor Will Geselbracht as a voting delegate to the Municipal Insurance Association of BC meetings of Subscribers, and Councillors Karen Proctor and Ian Savage as first and second alternate voting delegates, respectively
- issued a Development Permit for 7702 Lantzville Road to facilitate construction of shoreline protection works
- endorsed a grant application for \$25,000 to the Union of British Columbia Municipalities' Community Emergency Preparedness Fund for completion of Lantzville's evacuation route planning.
