Did you know? Bylaw 358 prohibits the removal of trees on greenfield (undeveloped) properties unless an exception is met. Bylaw 358 replaces Bylaw 331, which prohibited tree removal on properties greater than 1 acre.

City of Nanaimo

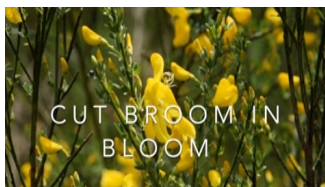

Minetown Day – Road Closures
