Did you know? As a result of bombing during WWI, the western European landscapes were ravaged and war-torn; despite these conditions, the resilient poppy flower continued to bloom. To Lt. Col. John McCrae, this symbolized the blood spilled on the WWI battlefields, and became the inspiration for the Canadian soldier and poet to author the prominent rondeau 'In Flanders Fields', outside of Ypres, Belgium.

Change The Batteries In Your Smoke Alarms

Daylight savings occurs on November 3, 2024 at 2:00am which means that it is also time to change the batteries in your smoke alarms too. It is also important to replace your smoke alarms every 10 years. More than one-third (38%) of residential fires resulting in death are due to no smoke alarms being present in the home. When working smoke alarms are present in your home, the risk of dying in a home fire are cut by 60% (according to the latest research by the National Fire Protection Association). **Fire alarms save lives.**

Effective November 1, 2024 all watering restrictions are lifted. We wish to thank the community for adhering to the various water restriction levels during the 2024 season. Your efforts in conservation will contribute to our future water supply and water sustainability overall.
