Development Cost Charge (DCC) Bylaw Update Underway

The District is reviewing the fees collected on new developments to pay for municipal infrastructure, such as water, sewer, drainage, and parks. The District of Lantzville has an existing Development Cost Charge Bylaw (DCC) which was adopted in January 2019 and needs to be updated to account for inflation and infrastructure needs for the municipality.

Property Tax Late Payment Penalties

Unpaid property taxes for 2025 have already been applied a 2% penalty. On September 16, 2025, a further 8% penalty will be applied to tax accounts with current year taxes outstanding.

Legislation and District of Lantzville bylaws do not allow penalties on unpaid taxes to be waived. There are no exceptions. Penalties are added to the current outstanding taxes or unclaimed home owner grants. Home owner grant applications must be submitted every year.
