DISTRICT OF LANTZVILLE BYLAW NO. 170, 2018

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR COUNCIL REMUNERATION

WHEREAS Council may, by bylaw, provide for the payment of remuneration to Council members for the discharge of the duties of their respective offices;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Lantzville, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Citation

1. This Bylaw may be cited as "District of Lantzville Council Remuneration Bylaw No. 170, 2018".

Council Remuneration

2. Remuneration for the Mayor and Councillors shall be paid in twelve (12) equal monthly installments.

- 3. The Mayor shall be paid commencing January 1, 2019 an annual indemnity of \$19,300, and commencing January 1, 2022 an annual indemnity of \$25,000, and each Councillor shall be paid commencing January 1, 2019 an annual indemnity of \$13,350.
- 4. When a Council member is appointed Acting Mayor for a period longer than 30 consecutive days in a year, that Council member will be paid, an additional indemnity equal to 15% of the annual Council member indemnity, prorated for the period of time in which they serve in the capacity of Acting Mayor.
- 5. The annual remuneration for Mayor and Councillors as set out in Section 3 will be increased by the same percentage as the Consumer Price Index for Victoria, British Columbia, published by Statistics Canada notwithstanding that the annual increase will be no less than 1%. The increase will be effective January 1 each year.
- 6. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 3 of this bylaw, a Mayor or Councillor serving only part of a year shall be paid only a corresponding proportion of their indemnity for that year.
- 7. The Mayor or Acting Mayor are hereby authorized to incur expenses for the entertainment of guests of the District or to promote the interest of the District and will be entitled to reimbursement of expenses as financially provided for in the annual budget. The cost for alcoholic beverages will not be reimbursed.

- 8. When authorized by Council to represent the District, engage in District business, or attend a meeting, course or convention beyond the boundaries of the District, the Mayor and Council members will be entitled to reimbursement of expenses incurred during their absences from the District in accordance with District of Lantzville, Travel Expense Reimbursement Policy, as amended from time to time.
- 9. Members of Council who are authorized or appointed by Council to represent the District on a board or organization within the boundaries of the Regional District of Nanaimo will be entitled to reimbursement of expenses by the District of Lantzville, if not reimbursed by the Board or organization, incurred as a result of this representation as outlined in section 9.

Review

10. Unless otherwise directed by resolution adopted by Council, a review of the remunerations for the Mayor and Councillors will be undertaken every five years from the adoption of this bylaw.

Benefits

- 11. Subject to availability Accident Insurance Coverage not to exceed \$250,000 may be made available to all Council members and, if acquired, the costs of such coverage will be borne by the District.
- 12. "District of Lantzville Council Remuneration, Benefits and Expenses Bylaw No. 97, 2012" and any amendments thereto are hereby repealed.
