Those unable to deliver nominations in person may swear the documents before a commissioner for taking affidavits in BC, and deliver to me by hand, mail, email or other delivery service, or by facsimile transmission before the Nomination Period closes at 4:00 pm on Friday, September 9th. If delivered by facsimile transmission or email, all originals must be delivered to me by 4:00 pm on Friday, September 16, 2022, otherwise, the person nominated is deemed to have withdrawn from being a candidate in the election.
